THE COLLEGE OF PHYSICIANS OF PHILADELPHIA INDUCTS 30 NEW FELLOWS

Fall 2022 Class of Inductees Includes Prominent Physicians, Academics, and Health Care Leaders from the Philadelphia Area and Nationwide

Philadelphia, Pa. (November 21, 2022) — On Friday, November 18, The College of Physicians of Philadelphia welcomed 30 new members to its distinguished Fellowship of prominent physicians, civic leaders, public health advocates, and academics.

Founded in 1787, the College, home of the Mütter Museum, is a non-profit organization with the mission of "advancing the cause of health while upholding the ideals and heritage of medicine." Biannually in the fall and spring, the College announces the induction of new members to its prestigious Fellowship program.

The inductees were inaugurated on the evening of Friday, November 18, when they signed their names into the College's historical register alongside renowned former Fellows, including: U.S. Founding Father Benjamin Rush, former Surgeon General C. Everett Koop, and Thomas Dent Mütter, who bequeathed his pathological collection to create the famous museum in his name. College Fellows support and advise a number of projects relating to the medical humanities, including: The widely popular <u>Mütter Museum</u>; <u>Historical Medical Library</u>; globally recognized and award-winning project <u>HistoryofVaccines.org</u>; and several <u>youth programs</u> to assist Philadelphia high school students in achieving successful careers in STEM.
